Instructions

- To certify your compliance with the National Research Council's Research Security requirements, complete the form and return it to the National Program Office. Keep a copy of the completed form for your records.
- The Principal Investigator is responsible for collecting and submitting an attestation form for each member of the project team who will have access to key project information, will be accountable for delivering on a portion of the project scope and/or provide critical and/or unique expertise to the project.
- It is the responsibility of the recipient organization to ensure students who will be members of the project team are in compliance with the National Research Council's Research Security requirements; Students are not required to complete an attestation.
